On Monday, May 7, 2007, the President and Mrs. Bush officially welcomed Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and His Royal Highness the Prince Philip Duke of Edinburgh to the United States. Dr. Dorothy I. Height and ten guests from the National Council of Negro Women were invited to be part of the arrival ceremony on the South Lawn of the White House. Other guests included British Embassy staff, Members of Congress, Cabinet Members, White House staff, State Department staff, and students. The ceremony included performances of the national anthems of both countries, a twenty-one-gun salute, and a formal review of troops by the President and the Queen.
